



2018 Pro Bono Paralegal Of The Year Award

Nomination Form

Purpose: This award recognizes an individual who is a practicing paralegal and has exhibited extraordinary dedication to the delivery of quality legal services to a portion of the population that cannot afford to pay for legal services.

Eligibility/Criteria: Nominees for this award must be members of the Pittsburgh Paralegal Association. The determination of the award recipient will be at the sole discretion of the judges. The recipient of the 2018 Pro Bono Paralegal of the Year Award will be honored by the Pittsburgh Paralegal Association at the holiday luncheon on Thursday, December 6, 2018 at the Engineers' Club.

The general criteria to be considered shall include, but not limited to:

- The nominee must have offered pro bono services designed to target a portion of the population who cannot otherwise afford legal assistance.
- Whether the nominee further enhanced the delivery of pro bono services within the legal community.
- The nominee must exhibit a true dedication to the delivery of quality legal services.
- In addition to the general criteria listed above, the panel judges shall review each Nomination Form and shall select the nominee whose pro bono community service activities exhibit a true dedication in assisting with the delivery of quality legal services to those who could not otherwise receive such services and assisting the community.
- Under no circumstances will the award be based upon the number of hours dedicated to a pro bono project. This award is designed to acknowledge the dedication and motivation of a paralegal that has enhanced the delivery of quality legal services to the less fortunate population and members of the community.
